Player Expectations

As a Player, you are expected to:

- Respect the game, by playing fairly and following the rules of the game.
- Show respect to the Refs, Teammates, Opponents, Coaches, Team Manager and Parents
- Encourage Teammates with cheers and positive comments.
- Demonstrate good sportsmanship before, during and after games.
For Example: End of game cheer and handshake or high fives.
- Do not speak negatively about players on either team.
- Always try your hardest, stay positive and hold your head up high.
- Let either coach or team manager and parent know if you are injured or not feeling well.
- Between practices work on your skills (Dribbling, Passing/Receiving and Conditioning).
- Remember win or lose, every game is an opportunity to get better. Think of one thing you want to work on before the next game and practice it.
- Come to practice ready (Cleats on, Shin guards on, Jewelry off, Ball out)

Parent Expectations

Parents are an important part of a players' soccer development and of a team's success. As such, parents' behavior on the sideline and support of their child is of the **utmost** importance. Towards that end, these bullets outline what is expected of parents in order to create a positive environment for all players.

- Display appropriate behavior on the sidelines at all times.
 - Respect Refs calls (we will have bad refs, and good ones that make mistakes)
- Encourage players with cheers and positive comments ONLY.
- Demonstrate good sportsmanship.
- Do not speak negatively about players on either team especially while on the sideline.
- Have players at practice and games on time.
 - (Watch for updates on Team Snap)
- Notify the Team Manager in advance if a player cannot attend a scheduled practice, game or team event.
- Be on time to pick up players, and stay tuned in the case of inclement weather.
- Support coaching decisions, trust there is a plan in place.
- Focus on effort and development — not just on winning.
- Provide a positive environment for learning and developing.
- Communicate with coaches if there are questions or concerns, but NOT during, before or immediately after the games. Email or text them to set a time to talk.
- Schedule vacations & camps around the soccer season when reasonably possible.
- You are responsible to ensure that all family members and guests you bring to games are aware of the expectations.

 - Cost per Tournament varies from \$50-\$75 (5-6x annually)
